Four wires are involved in supplying the main panel with power. Three of them will come from the utility pole, and a fourth (bare) wire.

The black wire is designated as the ungrounded, or "hot," conductor, meaning it carries the full electrical potential from the circuit breaker panel to the device or fixture.

Black wire is the standard hot conductor in residential 120V circuits -- always live when the breaker is on, regardless of switch position. White wire is neutral but carries full load current during operation; it ...

The black wire in the electrical outlet for home (residential) electricity purposes usually connects to the hot live post or terminator (bus bar has current). However, for other purposes, the ...
