"CE" basically stands for "Conformité Européenne" or "European Conformity." This marking shows that the product meets the European Union's safety, health, and environmental ...

The CE and UKCA markings must be clearly visible and legible when you affix it to the product. If this is not possible, you must attach these marks to the packaging (if any) or accompanying documents.

This guide breaks down exactly how CE labeling works, what packaging requirements manufacturers must meet, and how to avoid the most common compliance mistakes.

When a product is CE marked and bears the CE mark, specific information and markings should be included on the packaging to demonstrate compliance with EU directives, regulations and standards.
