In applications for registration of certification marks based on sections 1 and 44 of the Trademark Act and registrations resulting from such applications, goods and services are classified in two classes ...

Each category of goods or services is assigned a number from 1 to 45, also known as an international class. There are many items listed in each class; however, goods and services are ...

There are 45 trademark classes in total, divided into 34 classes for goods and 11 classes for services. Each class has a number and a description of the type of goods or services it covers.

The five categories of trademarks are generic, descriptive, suggestive, arbitrary, and fanciful. In terms of legal protection, they range from weakest (generic) to strongest (fanciful).

The system consists of 45 classes, with Classes 1-34 covering goods and Classes 35-45 covering services. You can find a brief overview of all classes in this article.

The International Trademark Classifications shown here are established by the Committee of Experts of the Nice Union and published by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO).
