

Distribution box leaky plate

The job of a distribution box is to equally divide the liquids exiting the tank throughout the entire S.A.S.. If the component is functioning properly it will prevent liquids from overloading one side of the leaching ...

If the top is quite uneven and leaky, and if you can't correct surface drainage to keep water away from the distribution box, you might need to add a compressible rubber or foam gasket between the D-box ...

If leaky, add a foam gasket or compressible rubber between the lid and the edges of the D-box. Also, consider correcting surface drainage around your property if you can.

Whether it is leaking from or leaking into the d-box, you should make sure that you do not seal the d-box lid or cover permanently. You should check the pipes inside the distribution box and observe if any ...
