

Does the armored pigtail go through a corrugated tube

Grasp the chest tube so that the tip of the tube protrudes beyond the jaws of the clamp, and advance it through the hole into the pleural space using your finger as a guide.

A pigtail catheter is simply a smaller, softer version of a chest tube, with a curled "pigtail" tip. Both do the same job -- removing air or fluid from around the lung -- but the big difference is in size and ...

PURPOSE: To outline the indications and procedure guideline for the insertion and removal of a chest tube (tube thoracostomy) or a pigtail catheter in a trauma patient.

Make a small incision with 11-blade alongside guidewire, then dilate to required depth with dilator, then insert pigtail with obturator over wire to appropriate depth.

Pigtail catheters are successfully used for the management of air or fluid in the pleural cavity. They differ from traditional chest tubes with respect to their smaller bore and flexibility leading ...

While the evidence in support of pigtail catheters over chest tubes for pneumothorax is clear, it remains to be determined if pigtails are beneficial in hemothorax.

Remove the trocar and guide wire, leaving the pigtail catheter in place, and suture the pigtail to the chest wall in a similar manner to conventional chest tubes.

The pigtail catheter insertion for pleural drainage is a safe and effective alternative to large-bore French chest tubes. Learn more about it here.

The optimal candidate for a pigtail catheter is a stable patient whose clinical condition can afford the additional time required for positioning and setup. In unstable patients, needle decompression and/or ...
