to provide (someone) with adequate intellectual or emotional resources: [~ + object + for + object] Those children are not equipped for such difficult math. [~ + object + to + verb] Nothing in our experience ...

equipped adjective (PREPARED) [+ to infinitive] having the skills, knowledge, or qualities needed to do something:

As an adjective, equipped describes something that is provided with what is necessary or appropriate. If you like to cook, you need a well equipped kitchen with lots of specialized pots and pans.

EQUIPPED definition: supplied with whatever gear or apparatus is needed for use or for any undertaking; outfitted. See examples of equipped used in a sentence.
