For example, a typical full-size rack cage is 42U high, while equipment is typically 1U, 2U, 3U, or 4U high. The rack unit size is based on a standard rack specification as defined in EIA -310.

Most chassis are designed to fit inside racks or cabinets. One rack holds multiple chassis; one chassis can hold one or several servers.
