Bear in mind that there is no "absolute" length of the tie, so don't pre-tie. The correct length of a tie is always relative to your waistband. Each person's torso is a different length, and different pairs of ...

A standard 57" tie works for most men, while extra-long ties (61"-67") are best for men 6' and taller. When tied, your tie should end near the middle of your belt buckle.

A quick way to gauge if your knotted tie is the right length for your body is to take note of the tail in relation to the keeper loop. If the tail tucks in without issue, you likely have the right size.
