

## Is it normal for the switch s indicator light not to turn on when the Fiber Optic cable is plugged in

If light is getting from A to B on one fiber but not the other, it's very possible you have a dirt, dust, or other particulate blocking light at one of the patch locations.

To check if the cable is working or not, try connecting the cable from one (1) port on the switch to another and check if the corresponding LED port status indicators lit up.

A port LED that is on does not guarantee that the cable is fully functional. The cable might have encountered physical stress that causes it to function at a marginal level.

No Light: The ONT is not receiving power. What to check: Make sure the power cable is securely plugged into both the ONT and a working wall outlet. If you're using a power strip, check that it's ...

Not lit: When the powered device is connected but the port indicator is not lit, it may be that the network cable is not plugged in tightly, the port itself is faulty, or the powered device does not ...
