A form of general-use switch so constructed that it can be installed in flush device boxes or on outlet box covers, or otherwise used in conjunction with wiring systems recognized by this subpart.

As used in this subpart, the term "construction" includes the erection of new electric transmission and distribution lines and equipment, and the alteration, conversion, and improvement of existing electric ...

According to Article 100 of the electrical code, "equipment" refers to a general category of devices, apparatus, fixtures, and systems or parts thereof that are involved in distributing or controlling ...
