To splice into a thimble with ears, shackle, or similar item, simply follow the directions of the splicing instructions, using the thimble or shackle bale to determine the eye size.

Use dry splicing technique as shown above. Generally when lacing on a single thickness of leather, it is recommended that you put enough lace in your needle to complete the area without splicing.

Cement splicing is commonly used by leather crafters and manufacturers of lace as well. Often on a spool of lace a piece will already be spliced to fill the roll length.
