Unlike primary light sources that create primary illumination, fill light serves a subtle yet critical purpose in shaping visual composition. In technical terms, fill light reduces the contrast of a ...

It is the secondary light in the traditional 3 point lighting setup. The fill light is typically positioned opposite of the key light to literally fill in the shadows that the key light creates. The ...

Fill light plays a critical role in controlling contrast and visibility. While the key light establishes direction and mood, the fill light determines how deep shadows appear and how much detail is retained.

A fill light is a secondary light source found opposite of the key light that fill in the shadows created by the key light in order to reduce contrast and increase details.
