Angled panels are intended to direct patch cables into vertical cable managers on either side of the rack. This facilitates maintenance and reduces the requirement for horizontal cable management.

Another name for a patch panel is passive hub. A patch panel is a hub only in the sense that it is a physical device in which wires are concentrated, but it cannot be used to network computers.
