



## Which port on the fiber optic cable is best for plugging in the router

It's analogous to the WAN port on a normal router. It looks like your fiber is already connected to the SFP port, though, so you shouldn't need to use the ONT port.

Connect the fiber optic cable from your ISP to the media converter's optical port. Connect an Ethernet cable from the media converter's Ethernet port to the WAN port on your Ethernet router.
